

2023 Oregon Active Transportation Summit - Move Into Action

Oregon boasts a long history of innovative transportation planning and investments, but it's also a place where many voices have been left out of pivotal decision-making, benefits have accrued inequitably, and even the most inclusive plans and processes languish. Our state is currently struggling with billions in system maintenance backlogs, is top-ten in the nation for traffic fatalities, and trips by single occupancy vehicle are rising rather than declining.

We know where we want to go – reduced VMT and GHG, reduced fatalities and crashes, and increased access to mobility and the opportunities it makes possible. And we have many experts, policies, tools and technology to get us there. So what's standing between our plans for a better future and implementation with urgency?

Our 2023 Summit, *Move Into Action*, will explore best practices for moving from ideas to execution, and provide a venue for exchanging strategies, tactics, and tools for bringing about the transportation future we've committed to achieve.

A primary goal for this year's summit is equipping and mobilizing decision makers, practitioners, advocates, community members, and youth to be active changemakers in bringing about a transportation future that is safe, accessible, racially equitable, and climate smart for everyone in our region and beyond.
